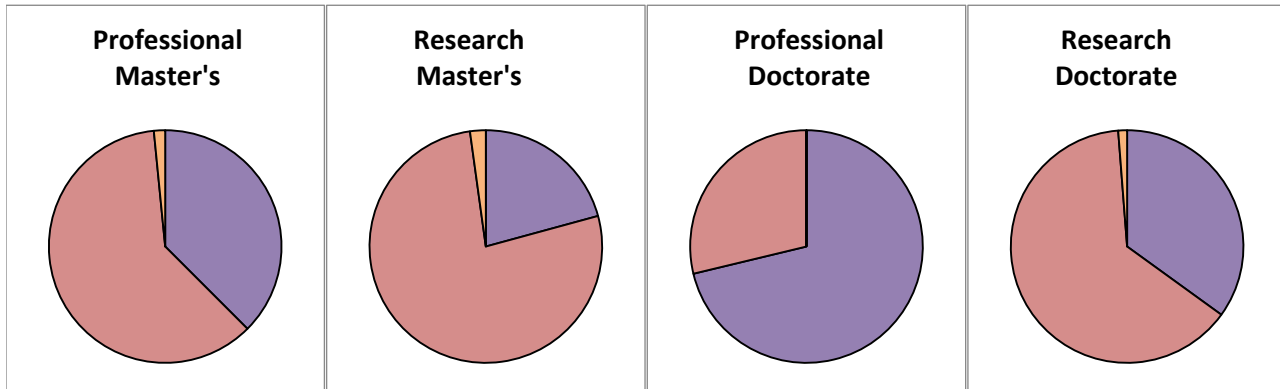


In your opinion, how knowledgeable are students about their career options **during graduate school?**

During graduate school, the level of knowledge about career options grew. Students in professional doctorate programs seemed to acquire more knowledge of career options than students in master's or research doctorate programs, with 71% of professional doctoral students believed to be very knowledgeable about career opportunities. Professional doctoral students were thought to acquire more knowledge of options than students in research doctorate and master's programs, where less than 50% were seen by graduate deans as very knowledgeable about careers.
